





Your first day

On your first day you will meet your team and consultant.

A consultant is a senior doctor who is in charge of your treatment. They plan your radiotherapy treatment and spend time with you and your family, learning all about you. You will also meet these people:

Your key worker

Nurses

The anaesthetic team (look for their blue pyjamas!)
Health play specialists

Temperature




Blood pressure



Pulse and oxygen numbers



Line or port



Anaesthetists are doctors that look after children and help them to have a sleep for their radiotherapy.

Your anaesthetist gives you the sleep medicine through your line or port and you will start to feel sleepy.

Your family will be with you.






When your treatment is finished, you will wake up.

You will be hungry and thirsty after your treatment and now you can have something to eat and drink... yummy!


