## **Prostate follow-up at Ashton Primary Care Centre**

Your after-care following prostate cancer treatment will be delivered at Ashton primary care centre.

The clinic is staffed by specialist Christie nurses who have expertise in managing prostate cancer patients.

At the appointment you will have opportunity to discuss any concerns regarding your prostate cancer, blood test results and treatment side effects. As far as possible, you will be able to see the same specialist nurse at each clinic visit to help with good continuity of care.

If at any point it is felt that you need to see a consultant urologist or specialist cancer doctor then you will have rapid access back into their clinic. We have recognised that it is useful to have an up-to-date PSA blood test performed **before** you get to the clinic so we have the results to hand on the day and we can then discuss them with you. **You need to make arrangements with your own GP practice for this blood test to be carried out 1 to 2 weeks before your appointment date.** Please bring a copy of the PSA result with you.

Your next Christie appointment will be at Ashton primary care centre. On arrival at the centre, please book in at the main reception and the staff there will direct you to the relevant waiting area where the nurse will call you through. Your appointment should last no longer than 20 minutes.

## Car parking

Parking spaces are available for blue badge holders in the car park to the rear of the centre.
