

Transport Strategy Update

May 2015



Actions taken forward

Communications/Marketing

- Personal travel planning offered to new starters
- Park & ride communications and marketing strategy progressing
- Health & wellbeing day – 19th March 2015 promoted:
 - Walkit.com urban route planner
 - Cycling – cyclescheme, Velocity, TfGM,
 - Public transport tickets and journey planning

Monitoring

- Green travel plan (2013-2030) Feb-15 progress report issued to MCC and published on the Neighbourhood forum page.
- S106 modal shift report (2015) submitted to MCC indicating 33.60% of all site staff use sustainable travel.
- A set of monitors are in place to monitor green travel plan progress – as agreed with MCC.

Cycling

- Installation of three new showers and a dry room due to be completed May-15.
- TfGM agreed to install a public bicycle pump as part of the Greater Manchester cycling strategy.
- Onsite bicycle maintenance provided (March-15)
- Onsite bicycle security marking provided (March-15)

Walking

- See Communications and marketing

Public Transport

- Discount First bus Manchester tickets now available and promoted to staff (May-15).
- Metrolink park & ride promoted for education events
- Christie accessibility analysis to be reviewed through the parking eligibility group.
- Unfortunately the HRMC guidelines does not allow salary sacrifice and internal discounts for public transport tickets.

Car share

- During car parking transfer numbers have been maintained.
- GM Car Share reviewed and trust will maintain its own internal database.

Offsite alternatives (park & ride)

- Tenders for shuttle services awarded to Belle Vue
- Park & ride permit system operating.

Car parking

- Eligibility criteria meeting held with management and union representation – on-going.
- Oak road car park closed and patients transferred to former golden lion (Car park D)
- Staff transferred temporarily to Oak road car park.



Actions Planned

Finance

- Initial park & ride will be free.
- TfGM LTSF grant application being made for match funding to improve cycling facilities.

Communications/Marketing

- Review internal public transport way finding for all stakeholders.
- Discussion on possible travel website improvements to take place with Media City.
- S106 communication exercise upon MCC supplying a final date. Extensive communication will take place including major sustainable travel promotions.
- Ongoing promotion of sustainable travel at trust corporate induction

Monitoring

- Quarterly review with MCC (May-15)
- Review public transport ticket sales.

Public Transport

- Discount First bus Greater Manchester to be monitored.
- Application for Northern rail season ticket to be available as an online form.

Cycling

- Installation of additional showers & dry room
- Major promotion of new shower block once opened.
- Monitor cycle stand usage
- During any project cycle stands/compound will be maintained
- Seeking quotes for cyclist tool stand
- Promotion of cyclists to go in next edition neighbourhood news

Walking

- Monitor progress regarding condition Palatine Road footpath – logged with MCC.

Car Share

- Review possibility of issuing new car share permits.

Offsite alternatives

- Trial park & ride
 - Confirm bus frequency once start date confirmed.
 - Development of shuttle service as take up increases

Car parking

- Eligibility criteria – staff consultation
