<b>3.</b>	<b>Tree Planting</b>	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Trust committed to replacing two trees for every one tree lost as part of MCRC and any future development.</li> <li>• Noted that 18 trees had been removed from the Paterson site and would be replaced 1:2.</li> <li>• Trust keen to involve residents in selection and location of trees. Involvement will be publicised via Neighbourhood News, social media, Christie website, Withington Civic Society.</li> </ul>	
<b>4.</b>	<b>CPZ Extension</b>	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Map of extension needs amending to include Lapwing Lane, Hill Street, Kingslea Road, Heyscroft Road, Heathside Road, Stephens Road.</li> <li>• MCC working to identify running costs and reducing them.</li> <li>• Final consultation area map to be circulated. Leaflet to also go to people outside area. It was noted by CNF that there was a limited sum of money.</li> <li>• Timescales – for implementation dependent upon S106 being signed.</li> <li>• MCC stated that the revenue costs of the CPZ needs to be resolved in order for S106 to be signed – revenue costs of the current circa £32k p.a.</li> <li>• Parking fines – CNF asked if parking fines could be considered to fund the revenue costs.</li> </ul>	MCC  MCC MCC

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Refurbished restaurant is now complete and is open to local residents.</li> <li>• Tiered car park – looking to start on site in Spring 2019.</li> <li>• Oak Road resurfacing is continuing. No parking restrictions currently in place.</li> <li>• Bridge Club has been purchased by the Christie Charity.</li> </ul>	ALL
<b>6.</b>	<b>Park and Ride</b>	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Park and Ride – 300 staff parking places will be displaced during construction of tiered car park.</li> <li>• 3 – 4 Park and Ride sites identified and subject to confirmation which include: Burnage Rugby Club and Withington Hospital.</li> <li>• Trust confirmed that contractor parking off site.</li> </ul>	
<b>7.</b>	<b>Paterson redesign</b>	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Current Strategic Planning Framework (SPF) silent on Paterson redevelopment.</li> </ul>	

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Advised to amend SPF by MCC to include the proposal.</li> <li>• Addendum to SPF. Will have pre-consultation on the 9<sup>th</sup> January for CNF members only.</li> <li>• Public drop-in pre-consultation on the 10<sup>th</sup> January 2019, 2 – 7 p.m.</li> <li>• Feedback on SPF addendum will be open until 24<sup>th</sup> January 2019.</li> </ul>
