What to look for after your biopsy

Following your biopsy, if you experience any of the symptoms below or have any problems or worries, please contact:

__ Liver biopsy

- ongoing or severe pain for more than 24 hours around the puncture site or elsewhere
- shortness of breath/difficultly breathing/chest pain
- fever/chills
- redness, swelling, warmth, bleeding or other drainage from biopsy site
- light-headedness, weakness, sweats or palpitations (a feeling that your heart is beating very fast).

Kidney biopsy

- blood in your urine (red or brown urine) for more than a week
- passing blood clots
- ongoing or severe pain for more than 24 hours around the puncture site or elsewhere
- faintness/dizziness
- inability to pass urine
- fever/chills.

___ Lung biopsy

- becoming breathless
- severe chest pain

(You must go to your nearest Accident and Emergency Department immediately if this happens)

- coughing up more than a tablespoonful of blood
- light-headedness, weakness, sweats or palpitations (a feeling that your heart is beating very guickly)
- fever.

Following your biopsy you should avoid heavy lifting and any strenuous activity.

A responsible adult must accompany you home and stay with you for at least 24 hours.



If you have had sedation, in the following 24 hours you must NOT:

- drive a car
- operate machinery
- drink alcohol
- sign any legal documents.
