

The Christie at Home service

Receiving intravenous chemotherapy or immunotherapy

The Christie at Home is a pharmacy and nurse led service delivering over 7,000 treatments a year to patients in their own home. The Christie at Home service is run by our Christie SACT trained nurses to ensure that standards of care and safety are consistent with our main site.

By receiving your treatment in your own home you are not having to travel to the main Christie site for your treatment. We are currently treating patients who live in the Greater Manchester area including; Altrincham, Bolton, Bury, Glossop, Leighton, Macclesfield, Manchester, Rochdale, Salford, Stockport, Tameside Trafford, Wigan and Cheshire.

You will continue to receive regular appointments to attend for a medical review either by telephone or face-to-face at The Christie.

If you are prescribed a treatment that is suitable for administration at home, your doctor will discuss this with you when you attend clinic. You will then be contacted by a member of The Christie at Home team to schedule your appointments and provide more information regarding planned visits.

The Christie at Home team will arrange with you to have the treatment delivered to your home by a courier. Delivery by the courier will be 2 days before your treatment day. The courier will contact you in advance to give you a 1 hour delivery slot. If you are receiving Eribulin, this treatment will be delivered by the courier on the day of the nurse's visit.

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If you need information in a different format, such as easy read, large print, BSL, braille, email, SMS text or other communication support, please tell your ward or clinic nurse.

Storage of treatment

Your treatment will need to be stored in your fridge at home. We advise you to place it in a sealed plastic box to separate it from your food.

If you have no treatments left at home and are due a planned visit from the nurse, then please call The Christie at Home team before the planned visit to arrange a further delivery.

If you require a blood test before treatment, this can be taken at one of The Christie Outreach or local phlebotomy clinics, closer to home.

Telephone assessment

The day before your treatment is due, one of The Christie at Home nurses will contact you to carry out a short telephone assessment. This assessment is an essential part of having treatment at home. During the call the nurse will ask you a series of short questions about how you have been feeling since your last treatment and any symptoms you may have experienced.
