## The specialist gynaecology nursing service

Our gynaecology cancer nursing service is offered by a team who have specialist knowledge and skills in both women's health and cancer treatments.

### The nursing service will provide:

- ongoing advice and support for patients, their partners, and families
- information and advice about treatment and treatment options
- a point of contact
- a link with other health care professionals involved in your care at home and in hospital
- advice about the menopause, HRT and alternatives
- discussion about fertility options (if appropriate)
- advice on sexual and relationship issues
- referral to specialist services, such as the sexual rehabilitation clinic, menopause clinic, lymphoedema clinic and specialist counselling service.

**Please contact the nursing service if you have any worries or concerns. They are always happy to talk to you. Working hours are Monday to Friday, 8am - 5pm. If there is no answer, please leave a message and they will call you back.**

## Nurse clinicians

You may see a doctor or a nurse clinician who is an experienced nurse. They have advanced training and education to allow them to carry out their role. You will have access to a clinical nurse specialist or nurse clinician from diagnosis and throughout your treatment. Nurse clinicians work on the wards and in the outpatient clinics.
